- The CssClass attribute of a server control

 - gets rendered in HTML as a class attribute
 - has to be set in Design or Split view
 - can be set to only one value
- A JavaScript shiv
 - lets the browser know that HTML5 elements are being used
 - lets the browser know that the HTML5 elements are block elements
 - lets search engines know that HTML5 elements are being used
 - lets CSS know that HTML5 elements are being used
- In practice, when you use an existing external style sheet for a new web page, you usually
 - adjust the HTML for the page to the selectors in the style sheet
 - adjust the styles in the style sheet to the HTML for the page
 - either adjust the HTML to the style sheet or the style sheet to the HTML
